Warning: Fraudulent Job Offers

Beware of fraudulent recruitment activities involving fake job offers and employment opportunities from individuals or organizations falsely claiming to represent Maple Reinders. Maple Reinders never asks for payment at any stage of the hiring process. If you are being asked to pay for visa processing, training, or application fees – this is a scam.

We only post job openings on our official website and trusted job portals. Any communication from our Human Resources team will come from an @maple.ca email address. Scammers may use emails or websites that appear legitimate to steal personal information, so always verify the sender's email address and website carefully.

To protect yourself, confirm job offers by contacting the company directly through a known, legitimate phone number or email address. Never pay upfront fees for a job or share personal information before verifying the job's legitimacy.

If you have fallen victim to a job scam, please report it to your local police and the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre.
